BRC Rule Update- June 2023

(Following June Advisory Committee Meeting)

Eligibility changes:

- Up to 10 Foundation points now permitted for Mixed 70cm classes in show jumping. Effective 1st October 2023
- Arena Eventing and Horse Trials will change from 0 to up to 10 foundation points being allowed. Rule effective from start of Winter 2023 qualifiers.

Rule Changes:

• DTM – 3.5

...... Test executed at the Championships, along with music used should fundamentally be the same as that which was ridden at qualifier. Removed with immediate effect.

- Challenge CC 1.6.1 Penalties
 5 second window either side of optimum time before penalties are added for all Challenge classes (cross country phase).
- **CC New Rule:** Compulsory retirement at 45 show jumping penalties at both Qualifiers and Championships
- CC New Rule: Rider will have 60 seconds from bell to exit start box.
- Arena Eventing: Change to 90 class which will become a mixed class and 70 class which will be split for classes for senior and junior. Rule effective from start of Winter 2023 Qualifiers.
- Combined Training: Heights for Combined Training classes changing from 75cm & 85cm to 70cm & 80cm. Effective from 1st April 2024.
- **Pairs Classes: New Rule** For all pairs competitions pairs can be made up from multiple clubs / areas. The pair can only compete at one qualifier per championship. With immediate effect.
- **Reserves G11:** For competitions that involve any form of jumping, reserves will be required to fill out a form to confirm the combination are capable of competing at the relevant height. With immediate effect.
- **SJ1.8.1:** Option 3 should read " Each team member will jump both rounds with the best three scores to count in each round for the team total. If a team member is eliminated, or gains in excess of 24 jumping penalties in the first round, they are not permitted to compete in the second round". With immediate effect.

Running Championship and Qualifiers:

- Where possible jump cups to be removed after competition hours in warmup areas, to prevent unsupervised jumping out of competition hours. With immediate effect.
- **Body Protectors: G22.3** In the event of an air jacket inflating whilst riding, it need not be removed for the rider to continue. With immediate effect.
- **Rider fall:** If a rider has two falls at the same event, at any time on the same day they should retire on medical grounds. **TBC when included into Handbook.** However, Official Stewards to decide on case by case until included in the Handbook.
- **Horse Fall:** A horse fall anywhere on site results in compulsory retirement of the horse from competing in any competition that same day. **With immediate effect.**
- **Appendix 1 National Championship:** Junior Dressage <u>Novice 24 is 2010</u> <u>version</u> – not 2006 which is no longer in use.
